The Holy Name Society is offering a Scholarship to assist students entering a two- year, four- year college or university or vocational training program. The amount of scholarship is dependent on the number of recipients and the availability of funds.

A. Previous scholarship recipients:

Students who received scholarships last year may reapply for their next year of college (2023-24) by submission of the following: current transcript; letter of good standing from the college or university; an essay describing your educational experiences and adjustments you made in your college matriculation; what are the positive experiences that have helped you become a responsible life-long learner in today's environment. Please include Student name and ID number, address, phone number, Email address and a current picture with your essay. **All students will be interviewed by the Holy Name committee and our pastor for approval.** We are requiring all scholarship recipients to volunteer to serve in our church community. (Examples include : tutoring youth, helping students with applications for college, serving meals to our sick and homebound on third Saturday of the month, making presentations during our annual scholarship prayer breakfast.)

B. All first time applicants will submit a package that includes:

- a. Acceptance letter from two-year or four-year college or university
- b. Transcript of grades from high school
- c. An essay to summarize your academic and extra-curricular high school activities
- d. Please state your goals and how you will use the scholarship.
- e. Name of scholarships, grants, tuition assistance received, or work study programs
- f. Letters of recommendation from teachers, counselor or pastor
- g. Proof of community service that you have completed in your community, school or church

Please send a current picture with your essay.

All applicants must be present for our annual Scholarship Prayer Breakfast on a Saturday in July.

Scholarships are awarded at the breakfast. All applicants will describe their learning experiences to our parish sponsors. (Date to be announced)
